Family Discipleship Questions – Week 1 – God is the Shepherd and our Shepherd

- 1) What does a Shepherd do? How is God the Shepherd?
- 2) Who are God's sheep based on Scripture?
- 3) What are three things that you know about God the Father (besides shepherd) and where do you find them in Scripture?
- 4) Does Jesus fulfill the role of shepherd, if so how?
- 5) Why is it a good thing that God is my shepherd?
- 6) What are do I do now as one of His sheep?

Family Discipleship Questions – Week 2 – God is Holy (holy, holy)

- 7) What are three things that are given the title of holy in Scripture?
- 8) What is holiness?
- 9) Why is holiness important as we grow in our understanding of God?
- 10) What does God's holiness have to do with us?
- 11) What is the gospel and how does it tie in with holiness? (1 Peter 1)
- 12) How can you this week, today even, be holy as God as holy?

Family Discipleship Questions – Week 3 – God is Love

- 1) What is true biblical love?
- 2) How does God show that He loves his people in the Old Testament?
- 3) What does it mean that love is unconditional and sacrificial?
- 4) How do passages like Ephesians 1:3-6, Romans 9:13-18, and John 21:15-17 help us get a better understanding of the love of God?

- 5) How are you going to put the two questions at the end of tonight into practice?

Family Discipleship Questions – Week 4 – God is Just

- 1) What is true biblical justice?
- 2) Why is God's justice important to our lives as Christians?
- 3) Read Micah 6:6-8. How would you answer the first question that Micah asks in verse 6 based on what we talked about tonight? (hint: Romans 3:23)
- 4) How do we rightly seek justice as believers? Can we seek justice in a wrong way?
- 5) How does God act on his standard of what is right and wrong in the Old Testament? How about the New Testament?
- 6) How does the justice of God relate to us? (Romans 3:23-26)

Family Discipleship Questions – Week 5 – God is Faithful

- 1) Do the application from tonight if you haven't done it, what are you waiting on?
- 2) How does God's faithfulness make him more personal?
- 3) Read 2 Corinthians 1:20-22. How does the faithfulness of God relate to Jesus?
- 4) What attribute of God that we have talked about so far, has most changed your view of God? Why?
- 5) What does it mean to trust God? How do we do that when we tell other about God?
- 6) How does learning about God's faithfulness draw you to trust Him more?
