## Family Discipleship Questions – Week 1 – New Creations Seek and Set

- 1) Read Colossians 1-2 by yourself and with someone else
- 2) Write down any questions or exciting things from the chapter
- 3) Tell someone in two sentences what you learned about tonight.
- 4) What consumes our mind and our thoughts most of the time (be honest!).
- 5) Why is Jesus worthy of our affections and our thoughts?
- 6) How did our study of joy ties into this week as we looked at what it means to be a new creation in Christ?

## Family Discipleship Questions – Week 2 – New Creations Put to Death

- 7) Reread the parts of Colossians that we have covered thus far (v1-11)
- 8) Why do you think Paul uses strong language in verse 5 when he is talking about killing sin?
- 9) Look through verses 5, 8-9 and reflect on your own walk with Christ.
  - a. Do any of these define you?
  - b. How are these things pulling you away from Jesus?
- 10) Why was it super important that Paul talked about unity in Jesus in verse 11?

## Family Discipleship Questions – Week 3 – New Creations Put On Christ

- 1) Reread Colossians 3:1-17 with someone in your family.
- 2) How can we live our lives as living sacrifices (Romans 12:1-2), who are being transformed by God (Col. 3:10)?
- 3) What is the gospel?
- 4) What does it mean to put on Jesus?
- 5) Why is it important/ what does it even mean that the Word of Christ dwell in us richly (3:16)?
- 6) Why should we give thanks to God in all that we do?
